

## The Champagne Météyer Père & Fils decorated by the UNESCO



Loyal to its tradition since 1860, the Champagne House Météyer received on June 23, 2017 the « Pierre Cheval de l'Embellissement » prize during the ceremony organized in Chalons-en-Champagne. This distinction, attributed by the UNESCO rewards the valors of authenticity and rigor of this entreprise producing Champagne for 5 generations. Accustomed to labels, the House had been recognized at the beginning of the year as « Champagne – refined art de vivre » by the Comité Interprofessionnel du Vin de Champagne (Interprofessional Comity of the Champagne wine). It also received the « Vignobles et Découvertes » label and became a member of the « Qualité Œnotouristique » network, becoming at the same time an international touristic link. The brand used all these recognitions in order to unveil in January 2017 its new tasting room. A new place where food and Champagne agreements are made. Artistic works of the whole world are also stocked, creating a unique universe.
